#### **Material Information**

#### **Your Information**

Your information has been, or will be, collected or received by us and we will manage personal data in accordance with data protection law and data protection principles. We require personal data in order, to provide good- quality insurance and ancillary services and will collect the personal data required to do this. This may be personal information such as name, address, contact details, identification details, financial information and risk details.

It is our policy only to process that personal information which is essential to the underwriting of each insurance product requested and we will only, process, your data for the purposes of insurance administration always in a lawful manner. In addition, your information will also be used for the purposes of insurance administration by insurers and their associated companies and agents by their reinsurers and by the Insured's insurance intermediary. It may be disclosed to regulatory bodies for the purposes of monitoring and/or enforcing Insurers compliance with any regulatory rules or codes. Your information may also be used for offering renewal research and statistical purposes and crime prevention. It may be transferred to any country (including countries outside the European Economic Area) for any of these purposes and for systems administration. Where this happens, we will ensure that anyone to whom your information is passed agrees to treat your information with the same level of protection as if we were dealing with it. If we give information about another person, in doing so you confirm that they have given you permission to provide it to us and for us to be able to process their personal data (including any sensitive personal data) and also that you have told them who we are and what we will use their data for as set out in the notice. In the case of personal data, with limited exceptions (and on payment of any appropriate fee) the data subject has the right to access and, if necessary, rectify information held about them. We or they may have the right to object to or restrict the processing of your or their personal information however, if you or they do this, we may be unable to continue to provide services to you and this may mean that we are unable to process your enquiry or claim or that your insurance cover will stop.
